

Arbitration Clause

All disputes which arise between the parties in connection with this agreement, or the subject matter of this agreement, shall be decided by an arbitrator agreed by the parties or, in default of agreement, appointed by the Dublin Resolution Centre or in the event of it being unwilling or unable to do so by the Law Society of Ireland provided always that these provisions shall apply also to the appointment (whether by agreement or otherwise) of any replacement arbitrator where the original arbitrator (or any replacement) has been removed by Order of the High Court, or refuses to act, or is incapable of acting or dies.

Mediation Clause

All disputes which arise between the parties in connection with this agreement, or the subject matter of this agreement, shall be referred to mediation facilitated by a mediator. The mediator will be chosen by agreement between the parties. In default of agreement, a mediator will be nominated by the Dublin Resolution Centre or in the event of it being unwilling or unable to do so by Law Society of Ireland. These provisions shall apply also to the nomination (whether by agreement or otherwise) of any replacement mediator where the original mediator (or any replacement) is conflicted from acting as mediator, or has been removed by Order of the High Court, or refuses to act, or is incapable of acting or dies.

Simple Combined Mediation and Arbitration Clause

All disputes which arise between the parties in connection with this agreement shall be referred to mediation, and in default of agreement of mediator, a mediator shall be nominated by Dublin Resolution Centre. In default of resolution at the mediation, the dispute shall be referred to Arbitration and in default of agreement of arbitrator, an arbitrator shall be nominated by Dublin Resolution Centre and the decision of the arbitrator shall be final.

More detailed combined Mediation and Arbitration Clause

All disputes which arise between the parties in connection with this agreement, or the subject matter of this agreement, shall be referred to mediation facilitated by a mediator. The mediator will be chosen by agreement between the parties. In default of agreement, a mediator will be nominated by the Dublin Resolution Centre or in the event of it being unwilling or unable to do so by Law Society of Ireland. These provisions shall apply also to

the nomination (whether by agreement or otherwise) of any replacement mediator where the original mediator (or any replacement) is conflicted from acting as mediator, or has been removed by Order of the High Court, or refuses to act, or is incapable of acting or dies

In default of resolution at the mediation, the dispute shall be determined by an arbitrator agreed by the parties (including the mediator if the parties and mediator agree or, in default of agreement, appointed by the Dublin Resolution Centre or in the event of the Dublin Resolution Centre being unwilling or unable to do so by the Law Society of Ireland provided always that these provisions shall apply also to the appointment (whether by agreement or otherwise) of any replacement arbitrator where the original arbitrator (or any replacement) has been removed by Order of the High Court, or refuses to act, or is incapable of acting or dies.
